Pat won the District Track Discus Throw his Senior Year – He represented the El Paso District in the Regional Track Meet.

Pat attended University of Wyoming on a Football Scholarship – He stopped playing football because of a knee injury.

He transferred to UTEP and graduated with a B.S. Degree in Business Management.

Pat worked in a business sales & management function during most of his career. He was a high level Executive Manager with C.E. Shepherd in Houston and Keystone Inc. working out of Houston, based in Chicago.
